

2017



Welcome to the 2017 IUPUI School of Liberal Arts Entering Student Survey Report

The Entering Student Survey is a yearly survey administered during New Student Orientation sessions. Students complete the online Qualtrics-based survey during a dedicated block of time to ensure they have enough time to complete the survey. The survey is voluntary and students are encouraged to complete it to ensure that we understand the support and resources they need to make successful transitions to IUPUI. Of the 145 beginning freshmen in the School of Liberal Arts, 82 completed the Entering Student Survey. The response rate was 57%. Of the 57 beginning freshmen Liberal Arts pre-majors, 23 completed the Entering Student Survey. This is a response rate of 40%.

Key Highlights Overall

- Compared to all other direct-admit students, School of Liberal Arts direct-admit students
 were more likely to rate themselves higher on writing ability and ability to work with others
 different from you, work more both on and off campus, chose a major because it aligns
 with their interest, and chose IUPUI because of the availability of specific academic
 programs (majors).
- Compared to all other University College pre-major students, School of Liberal Arts pre-major students were more likely to rate themselves higher on their ability to manage finances, and chose IUPUI because of a visit to IUPUI's campus.
- Compared to all School of Liberal Arts pre-major students, School of Liberal Arts directadmit students rated themselves lower on study skills and ability to manage finances, more likely to change their career choice and more likely to expect to obtain an advanced degree.
- 90% of Liberal Arts students agree that the IUPUI campus is welcoming.
- School of Liberal Arts direct-admit respondents rated themselves higher in writing ability (mean 3.89) than other students (mean 3.50 for all students) while they rate themselves lower on mathematical ability (2.91 Liberal Arts students and 3.42 Overall students).
- 70% of direct—admit Liberal Arts students felt there is a 'Very Good Chance' they will be satisfied with college life.
- 65% of Liberal Arts respondents have 'Some' concerns about their ability to finance their college education.
- Top 5 reasons School of Liberal Arts direct-admit respondents reported choosing IUPUI were 'Availability of specific academic programs (major)', 'Availability of financial aid/scholarships', 'Cost', 'Job, career, and internship opportunities available in Indianapolis while attending school', and 'Career and job opportunities available in Indianapolis after I complete my degree'.
- Nearly identical percentage of Liberal Arts direct-admit respondents plan to pursue a Graduate degree as the Overall respondents (45% Liberal Arts, 44% Overall).
- Liberal Arts respondents had a lower mean (4.89) on 'IUPUI was my first choice of college that I was accepted to or considered applying to' than the Overall respondents (5.17).
- The School of Liberal Arts direct-admit students have nearly identical levels of agreement and disagreement on the sense of belonging items compared to the overall beginning freshmen respondents.









How committed are you to your current major?






What is the highest degree you expect to obtain?




What is the likelihood that your will transfer from IUPUI to another college?




EXPECTED LIVING SITUATION


How committed are you to your current major?



What is the highest degree you expect to obtain?




