

School of Social Work Beginning Freshmen Entering Student Survey Report



Welcome to the 2017 IUPUI School of Social Work Entering Student Survey Report

The Entering Student Survey is a yearly survey administered during the first day of a student's orientation. The students are given the link to the survey during a dedicated block of time to ensure they have enough time to complete the survey. The survey is not required to be filled out, but it is encouraged as some responses may be used to ensure they get information to resources to help them succeed in college. Of the 38 School of Social Work beginning freshmen pre-majors in the 2017 cohort, 15 completed the Entering Student Survey. That is a response rate of 40%.

IUPUI's Vision

To be a leading urban research institution recognized for the success of its students, its advances in health and life sciences, and its intellectual, economic, and cultural contributions to the wellbeing of the citizens of Indianapolis, the state of Indiana, and beyond.

Key Highlights Overall

- 86% of Social Work respondents agree that the IUPUI campus is welcoming.
- 79% of Social Work respondents reported that being a hard worker is 'Very much like me.'
- Social Work respondents rated themselves highest compared to other students in 'Ability to work with others that are different than you' with a mean of 4.15.
 Overall respondents had a mean of 3.96 for the same item.
- 46% of Social Work respondents plan to spend between 11 and 20 hours 'preparing for class (studying reading, writing, doing homework or lab work, analyzing data, rehearsing, and other academic activities)' compared to 38% of Overall respondents.
- The number one reason students chose their major was that it 'aligned with their interests'.
- Top 5 reasons Social Work respondents decided to attend IUPUI: 'Job, career, and
 internship opportunities available in Indianapolis while attending school', 'Availability of
 financial aid/scholarship', 'Availability of specific academic programs (majors)',
 'Graduates get good jobs', 'Social Climate/Activities at the College'.
- 69% of Social work pre-major respondents reported that job, career, and internship opportunities available in Indianapolis were Extremely Important to choosing IUPUI, compared to 39% of overall beginning freshmen respondents reporting the same.
- 79% of Social Work pre-majors feel the trait being a hard worker very much describes them, compared to 59% of overall beginning freshmen respondents reporting the same.














How committed are you to your current major?





What is the highest degree you expect to obtain?




What is the likelihood that your will transfer from IUPUI to another college?
