INTRODUCTION

The Indiana College Substance Use Survey was administered in Spring 2013. A random sample of 3,000 IUPUI students was sent an e-mail inviting them to participate in the survey. Students were given a two-week period to complete the online questionnaire. A reminder e-mail was sent to all students midway through the survey period. 477 students responded to the survey, for a response rate of 15.9%. A description of the history and methodology of the Indiana College Substance Use Survey can be found in the *Results of the Indiana College Substance Use Survey*, 2013 at www.drugs.indiana.edu/data-survey_icsus.html.

Three criteria were used to clean the data. Surveys were discarded if any of the following conditions were

- missing gender information,
- inconsistent responses on substance use across time measures (monthly vs. annually)
 for more than one-third of the substances queried, and
- pharmacologically-implausible patterns of responses (i.e., a combination of drugs and frequencies of use whose cumulative effect would be lethal).

A total of 33 surveys were rejected due to meeting at least one of the criteria, leaving 444 usable surveys (93.1%).

KEY FINDINGS

ANNUAL PREVALENCE

Almost nine in ten of the IUPUI students (84.9%) reported using alcohol in the past year, including almost three-fourths of the students under 21 (72.5%) (See Table 3). Approximately one-fifth of the students reported using cigarettes (23.9%), tobacco with a hookah (23.0%), cigars (22.1%), and marijuana (21.6%). Use of marijuana in the past year by IUPUI students was significantly lower than the statewide rate (all Indiana students participating in the 2013 survey) of 33.5%. One in ten of the IUPUI students (10.4%) reported taking prescription medications not prescribed to them in the past year. The misuse of prescription medications was the most common substance used after alcohol, tobacco, and marijuana.

Male students reported significantly higher rates of cigar and smokeless tobacco use than the female students. Almost one-third of the male students (30.2%) smoked cigars in the past year and one in ten (9.4%) used smokeless tobacco. Female students reported statistically higher rates of alcohol use than male students (87.5% vs. 79.9%, respectively). When analyzed by age, over one-third of the students under 21 reported using marijuana (37.5%) and smoking tobacco with a hookah (35.0%).

MONTHLY PREVALENCE

Two-thirds of the IUPUI students (65.5%) reported alcohol use in the past month, and one in eight used marijuana (11.9%) and cigarettes (11.5%). Both the marijuana and cigarette use rates were significantly lower than the statewide rates (Table 5). Almost half of the IUPUI students under 21 (48.8%) drank alcohol in the past month, and approximately one-fourth of the underage students (23.8%) used marijuana in the past month. Female students reported a higher rate of alcohol use than the male students (69.2% vs. 58.4%, respectively).

BINGE DRINKING

Binge drinking was defined in the Indiana College Substance Use Survey as four or more drinks in one sitting for females and five or more drinks in one sitting for males. This gender-specific standard follows the definition established by the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism. Over one-third of the IUPUI students (38.3%) reported binge drinking in the past month, which was significantly less than the statewide rate (Table 7). Over one-fourth of the IUPUI students (27.9%) reported binge drinking in the past two weeks (Table 8). There was no significant difference in binge drinking rates among gender or age classifications.

One in five IUPUI students (20.0%) reported binge drinking once or twice in the past two weeks, and 8.0% reported doing so three or more times (Figure 1).





PRESCRIPTION DRUG MISUSE

The most common prescription drugs misused by IUPUI students in the past six months were Adderall (5.4%), Xanax (3.6%), and Vicodin (3.4%). There were no significant differences in the rates of prescription drug misuse between gender or age categories.



COMBINING ALCOHOL WITH ENERGY DRINKS OR OTHER STIMULANTS

Almost one-quarter of the IUPUI students who reported drinking alcohol in the past six months (22.6%) combined alcohol with energy drinks, while 5.7% combined alcohol with other stimulants.


Figure 2. Percentage of Students Who Drank Alcohol in Past Six Months, Who Combined Alcohol with Energy Drinks or Other Stimulants, 2013 (n = 367)



USUAL TYPE OF ALCOHOL

Students who drank alcohol in the past six months were asked what type of alcohol they usually drank. Beer was reported as the most common kind of alcohol (33.5%), followed by liquor (31.6%).

REASONS FOR ALCOHOL USE

Students who drank alcohol in the past six months were asked their reasons for drinking alcohol. The most common reason for drinking alcohol was "to have a good time with my friends" (81.5%). Other common reasons were "to relax or relieve tension" (70.0%) and "because it tastes good" (67.0%). (Table 10).

Male students were more likely to indicate "boredom" as a reason they drink (21.1%), as were students under 21 (25.5%). Underage students were also more likely to report "to feel good or get high" (50.9%), "to experiment" (29.1%), "to seek deeper insight" (20.0%), "to fit in with a group I like" (16.4%), and "to get away from my problems" (23.6%) while students over 21 selected "because it tastes good" at a higher rate than underage students (70.8% vs. 45.5%, respectively).

CONSEQUENCES OF SUBSTANCE USE

Table 11 presents findings on select consequences reported by IUPUI students as a result of their drinking. Over half of the IUPUI students who drank alcohol in the past six months (55.6%) reported having a hangover, and one in six (18.8%) reported blacking out. One in five of the students (21.3%) reported feeling bad or guilty about their drinking.

Over two-fifths of IUPUI students who used drugs in the past six months (42.4%) had driven a car while under the influence of drugs. Approximately one-third of the students who used drugs reported abusing more than one drug at a time or feeling bad about their drug use (30.3% each).

AGE OF FIRST TIME USE

The IUPUI students participating in the survey first used cigarettes at an average age of 16.6 years, and first used alcohol at an average age of 17.3 years. The average age of first use of marijuana among IUPUI students was 17.7 years, which was older than the average age of all Indiana students participating in the 2013 survey.

ALCOHOL AVAILABILITY


Underage students who used alcohol in the past year were asked to identify the three easiest ways they obtain it (Table 14). Two-thirds of the students (67.2%) listed older friends as the easiest way they obtain alcohol, and almost all (98.2%) selected it as one of the three easiest ways. Off-campus parties were selected by 43.1% of the students as one of the top three ways to get alcohol. One in seven of the underage IUPUI students who use alcohol (13.8%) reported purchasing it from a retailer in the past six months (Figure 4).

PERCEPTION OF PEER BEHAVIORS AND BELIEFS


Students were asked how many alcoholic drinks they thought the typical student at their school consumed the last time he or she partied/socialized. Students could provide any figure between 0-30. The average of the responses from IUPUI students was 5.4 drinks. Male students believed the typical student consumed more drinks (average of 5.9 drinks) compared to female students (average of 5.1 drinks) (Table 15). Over half of the students (56.8%) thought the average student consumed five or more drinks the last time he or she partied (Figure 5).

The survey also asked participants how they thought other students on their campus felt about using certain substances. Only 12.6% thought their peers would disapprove (somewhat or strongly) of trying marijuana once or twice, and only 17.6% felt their peers would disapprove of smoking it occasionally. Approximately one-third of the IUPUI students (31.8%) thought their peers would disapprove of taking one or two drinks of alcohol nearly every day and half (49.1%) thought they would disapprove of having five or more drinks in one sitting.

MENTAL HEALTH

Two questions to assess mental health status were asked on the Indiana College Substance Use Survey. Students were asked on how many days in the past month their mental health was not good, including experiencing stress, depression, or problems with emotions. The average response was 6.3 days (Table 17). One in eight of the students (13.5%) indicated that they had thought they would be better off dead or of hurting themselves in some way in the past 2 weeks (Table 18). Over one-fourth of the students under 21 years of age (26.3%) indicated having such thoughts, compared to 10.8% of students 21 or older.

GAMBLING BEHAVIOR

The most common form of gambling reported by IUPUI students was playing the lottery (34.7%), followed by gambling at a casino (19.6%). Both of these rates were significantly higher than the rates reported by all Indiana students surveyed. Male students reported much higher rates of gambling than female students for several gambling behaviors. Over one-fifth of the male students gambled in betting pools (21.5%) and bet on fantasy football (22.1%). One in six male students (16.8%) played cards at home for money in the past year, compared to 7.5% of the female students. Students aged 21 or older were more likely to report playing the lottery in the past year (37.6% vs. 21.3% of students under 21).

Students were asked how frequently they gambled to assess the level of problem gambling. Slightly more than one percent of the students (1.4%) reported playing the lottery at least once a week in the past year, while less than one percent reported participating on a weekly or more frequent basis in any of the other surveyed gambling behaviors.




Figure 6. Percentage of Students Who Reported Weekly or More Frequent Gambling in the Past Year, by Gambling Category, 2013




Figure 7. Most Frequent Gambling Location (Other Than Online or Lottery) in Past Year, 2013

The most frequent location that IUPUI students reported for gambling (other than online or playing the lottery) was at a casino (14.9%), followed by an apartment or house (5.4%) (Figure 7). The most common negative consequence of gambling reported by IUPUI students was feeling bad about gambling (3.9%) (Table 20).
